



### FUNDING IS ALWAYS NEEDED - CAN YOU HELP?

As Harold our Treasurer points out on page 1 of the newsletter we are very grateful to you all for whatever you can give, and you can be assured that your money is spent wisely and on-the-ground in Ghana (98% of what we raise is spent in Ghana on materials and projects). We always make sure we only work with those communities who want to help themselves, and their children, to break free from poverty. We work closely with, and listen to, the communities right from the start. This enables us to really understand what is needed, what is possible and how we can help them to help themselves. **Our most urgent needs are listed below - please contact us if you would like more information and how you can help. ### MISCELLANEOUS NEEDS: It is surprising that we achieve so much every year with such low sums of money.

We always need desks for our schools. These cost about £35 each for desk with a bench.

In our Vocational Schools, the heads do what they can to raise funds to renew and replace equipment. But as numbers grow, the temptation is to cut down on practical work. So any help with funding for catering, tailoring, batikue, printing materials would be greatly appreciated. Our vocational schools that have electricity really need to introduce computers and screens. These are expensive but we try to help where we can. Because of transport costs, it is usually more economical to buy in Ghana than to send from here.

Our truck needs repairs and frequent new tyres (the roads are terrible).....and many more urgent needs!

### FOUR SCHOOLS URGENTLY NEEDING OUR HELP



**Zanzugu-Yipala** - cracking up. The Headmaster proudly shows his 'office' under the crack - £32,000 for 3 rooms and a store & £7,000 for toilet block needed.



**Cheshugu** - derelict. £49,000 needed for 6 rooms and store & £7,000 for a toilet block. Despite local village efforts now turned to WULUGU in desperation.



**Boakudo** - £32,000 for lower primary, £9,000 for Upper primary repair & £7,000 for toilets needed. Currently a dangerous mud structure.



**Sanga** - £32,000 for 3 rooms & a store & £7,000 for a toilet block needed. Struggling to cope in the old building but may need to close shortly without a new building.
